

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF WEYBURN NO. 67

BYLAW NO. 8-2022

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR CIVIC ADDRESSING WITHIN THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF WEYBURN NO. 67

The council of the Rural Municipality of Weyburn No. 67 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. That this Bylaw shall be referred to as the Civic Addressing Bylaw.

Civic Address Assigned

2. Properties whose driveways attach to internal subdivision roadways shall be assigned civic addresses using the *Saskatchewan Address Assignment System for Urban Areas*, unless otherwise specified and approved by the Municipality and shall conform to the regulations below:

- a. Odd and even civic numbers shall be on opposite sides of the road. Properties on the South or East side of a road would receive an Odd number. Similarly, properties on the North and West side of a road would receive an Even number;
 - b. Cul-de-sacs: the point where the odd and even numbers meet should be positioned to be at the furthest point from the intersection of the cul-de-sac and the road that is connects to;
 - c. Circular Road: The civic numbering shall start at the lowest numbered intersection and the odd and even numbers on alternating sides of the roads. As the Rural Addressing System increasing the numbers going North and West, the lowest intersection is considered to be the intersection that is most Southerly and Easterly;
 - d. Properties that are located on the corner of two roads shall be addressed according to where the main entrance of the property meets the road;
 - e. In the event of uneven lot sizes or circular roads, numbers may be eliminated in order to maintain proper number sequencing;
 - f. Properties adjacent to two roads will be assigned two addresses; however, the property will only be eligible for one address which will be assigned according to the location of the main entrance to the property.
3. Properties whose driveways attach to any public roadway, not an internal subdivision road, shall be assigned civic addresses using the *Saskatchewan Provincial Standard System of Rural Addressing*, unless otherwise specified and approved by the Municipality and shall conform to the regulations below:
 - a. Each mile of Township Road/Range Road is divided into 40 meter lot intervals producing 80 addressable lots.
 - b. Even Numbers are on the South and West side of the road; Odd Numbers are on the North and East side of the road.

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- c. Address numbers increase going North and West.
- d. If two access locations are within the same 40 meter lot interval on the same side of the road, a letter designation will be appended to the suffix of the civic number (example 28034A Range Road 3135);
- e. If there is a single access to multiple properties, a numerical designation will be appended to the prefix of the civic number (example: #1-28034 Range Road 3135).

- 4. The Municipality shall be responsible for maintaining the numbering system and shall keep record of all civic addresses assigned.

Civic Number Display

- 5. Civic numbers shall be posted in a location that is not obstructed from view when viewed from the closest place to the traveled portion of the roadway from which the principle building or lot;
- 6. The owner of the property shall maintain the civic number for the property and ensure it in good order.

Prohibited Posting

- 7. No person or persons shall post or permit to be posted any part of a civic address which is not assigned to the property;
- 8. No person or persons shall display on a property any number which is not the assigned civic address with the exception of the Legal Land Description, a lot number, unit number or a number which is clearly party of a name;
- 9. No lot number, unit number or suite number or any similar shall be posted within the word "lot", "unit" or "suite" proceeding the posted number;

Coming into Force

- 10. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the date of final approval of Council for the Rural Municipality of Weyburn No.
