RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF WEYBURN NO 67 Weyburn, Saskatchewan

BYLAW NO. 10-2002

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN THE HAMLET OF RALPH.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Weyburn No. 67 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- In this bylaw the expression:
 - "public highway" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Highways
 Act, but shall not include a provincial highway as designated in pursuance
 of such Act;
 - (b) "the motor vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Vehicles Act.
- No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 40 km per hour on a public highway within the Hamlet of Ralph.
- Section 2 shall not apply to the operator of a fire engine, fire department apparatus
 or police car when on emergency duty.
- Any person guilty of an infraction of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.

5. Bylaw No. 73-2 is hereby repealed.
