

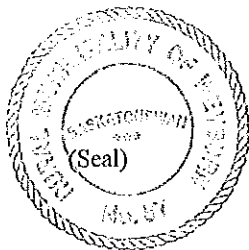

BYLAW NO. 12-2002

A BYLAW TO RESTRICT LITTERING AND TO COMPEL THE REMOVAL OF DIRT, STONES, FILTH OR RUBBISH OR ANY OTHER ENCUMBRANCE OFF THE MUNICIPAL ROADS OR OTHER PUBLIC PLACES WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY, AS PER SECTION 206(2) (H) OF *THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY ACT, 1989*.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Weyburn No. 67 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. No person shall deposit any dirt, filth, rubbish or any other encumbrance on any road, road allowance, land acquired for the widening of or diversion from a road allowance, lane or other public place within the municipality.
2. Any person found guilty of an infraction of this bylaw shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$2,000.00 as provided for in the General Penalty Bylaw No. 2-1990.
3. Bylaw Nos. 6-1989 and 1-2000 are hereby repealed


