

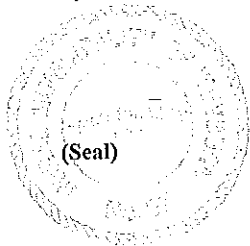


A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF DOGS WITHIN THE RURAL
MUNICIPALITY OF WEYBURN NO.67

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Weyburn No. 67, of the Province of Saskatchewan,
enacts as follows: _


1. The Weyburn Humane Society shall act as the Pound Keeper.
2. Designated Officers shall be any member of Council or employee of the Rural Municipality of Weyburn No. 67.
3. No dog shall run at large in the Rural Municipality of Weyburn No.67 , and for the purpose of this bylaw, a dog shall be deemed to be running at large when it is beyond the boundaries of the land occupied by the owner, possessor or harbourer of the said dog, or beyond the boundaries of any lands where it may be with the permission of the owner or occupant of the said land and when it is not under control of being:
 - (a) in direct and continuous charge of a person competent of controlling it; or
 - (b) securely confined within an enclosure; or
 - (c) securely fastened so that it cannot roam at will.
4. A person who owns, possesses or harbours a dog found running at large shall be deemed guilty of an infraction of this bylaw.
 - (a) Any dog found running at large contrary to the provision of this bylaw shall be reported to the "designated officers" who may instruct the poundkeeper to have the dog picked up and taken to the municipal pound, where it shall be kept for three days unless the owner, possessor or harbourer redeems the dog by paying to the pound keeper the sum of \$50 for each dog impounded, and the costs incurred for the care and keep of each dog per day. Only dogs okayed by the "designated officers" shall be accepted by the Weyburn Humane Society
 - (b) Any dog which is not redeemed within three days may be sold or disposed of by the poundkeeper, The Rural Municipality of Weyburn No. 67 . will pay the \$50.00 pickup fee to the pound.
5. A person found guilty of infraction of any provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
6. Bylaw No. 75-2 is hereby repealed.

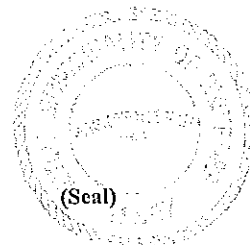
