## BYLAW NO. 11-1994

A BYLAW RESPECTING ENCUMBERING AND OBSTRUCTING ROADS.

The council of the Rural Municipality of Weyburn no. 67, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- In this bylaw the expression "road" means any public highway within this municipality as defined by The Highways and Transportation Act, other than a provincial highway as designated pursuant to such Act.
- No person shall encumber or obstruct a road in the municipality by leaving a vehicle, or other article or thing standing thereon.
- Any person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw
