



BYLAW NO. 3-1999

A BYLAW TO RESTRICT THE SPEED LIMIT ON A CERTAIN MUNICIPAL ROAD.


The Council of the Rural Municipality of Weyburn No. 67, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this Bylaw the expression "motor vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Vehicles Act.
2. Pursuant to Section 206(2)(c), Rural Municipality Act, 1989, the speed limit on the road south of Highway No. 39 through SW 11-8-14-w2 to the south side of Section 3-8-14-w2 shall be a maximum of 60
~~3.~~ kilometres per hour.
4. Any person guilty of an infraction of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
