BYLAW NO. 9-1993

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE EXTINGUISHING OF FIRES AND FOR LEVYING COSTS PURSUANT TO SECTION 215(1) OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY ACT, 1989.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Weyburn No. 67, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Subject to the availability of the fire fighting men and equipment, the Rural Municipality of Weyburn No. 67, will provide fire fighting services throughout the municipality.

1. The cost of the fire fighting service shall be charged directly on the persons who receive this service.
2. The following fee for service will be levied for each and every fire fighting service:
 - (a) For ratepayers of the Municipality \$ 50.00 per call.
 - (b) For non-ratepayers \$100.00 per call.
3. The "fee for service" levy shall be in addition to the actual costs incurred for fire fighters fees, vehicle fuel expense, equipment rental and City of Weyburn charges for the use of their men and equipment at the site of the fire.
