## RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF WEYBURN NO. 67 Weyburn, Sask.

## BYLAW NO. 1-1983

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONTROL AND DESTRUCTION OF GRASSHOPPERS ON LAND WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Weyburn No. 67 in the Province of Saskatchewan under the provisions of the Pest Control Act, enacts as follows:

In this bylaw the expressions: "Chemical Distribution Outlet" means the depot as appointed by Council from time to time. "Committee" means members appointed by the Municipality.

"Council" means the Council of the Rural Municipality of Weyburn No. 67. "Municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Weyburn No. 67.

- "Owner" includes every person who owns, occupies or controls land within the Municipality.
- The Council shall, in each year, appoint a committee, to be known as the "Grasshopper Controll Committee" to administer this bylaw. 2.
- Every owner shall take the following measures for the control and 3. destruction of grasshoppers:
  - (a) He shall be responsible for the application of chemicals on his land, that is, in his opinion and/or in the opinion of the committee, warrants such application; and
  - He shall be responsible for the application of chemicals within the area lying between the centre line of the road allowance adjoining his land and the nearest boundary of the said land, that is, in his opinion and/or in the opinion of the committee, warrants such application.
  - (c) He shall trap strip all of his stubble fields within the area of the municipality where he has failed to destroy all green growth early and before grasshoppers hatch, that is, in his opinion and/or in the opinion of the committee, warrants such application.
- The Council shall designate Chemical Distribution Outlets as such chemicals are needed from time to time.
